

How to Make 40 Blocks from 1 Jelly Roll

Start with four strips; remove selvages, cut each strip into 4 equal lengths.
Number colors 1, 2, 3 and 4.

Sew strips together into groups of four, changing the color placement in each group.



Cut each unit into four 2 1/2" strips.



Sew a strip from each unit together to make a block, changing the color placement for each block.



You will end up with four 8 1/2" blocks.



SO...out of a forty strip Jelly Roll you can make **FORTY different blocks!** These can be set together with or without sashing, it's your choice!
This quilt is made from 16 blocks.

This quilt uses 16 blocks with 2" sashing, cornerstones and borders
