

River's Edge Fabric Company Block of the Month 2009 - 2010

These blocks were originally designed for the Saturday Sampler Program at the River's Edge Fabric Company in 2008. You may share the blocks and finishing instructions with your friends and guild members, but please remember to give design credit to the River's Edge Fabric Company!

We offered the quilt in two color ways, brights and earthtones, both were scrappy! We LOVE scrappy at the River's Edge and encourage you to dig into your scrap bags, baskets and boxes to make this quilt! You paid good money for those scraps; we challenge you to USE THEM!!

Fabric Requirements

Background 1 ½ yards total		Blocks 2 yards total
Sashing & Inner Border 1 ¾ yards	Corner Stones ¼ yard	Pieced Border 1 ½ yards
Binding ½ yard		Backing 5 yards

The pieced border is sixty (60) 4 ½" (4" finished) 4-Patch blocks. If you make five a month, by month twelve your border blocks will be finished!

To make your 4-Patch blocks use left over 2 ½" strips or cut 2 ½" squares from your scrap basket. Finished blocks will measure 4 ½".



This is what my quilt looks like. My background is white with black question marks on it and obviously I used the brights! Because of the question mark fabric I named my quilt WHAT?!? Hope you have as much fun as we did!
