Use a SCANT 1/4" seam allow

Fabric 1
Two - 4 1/4" squares
Two - 4" squares



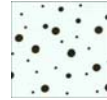
Fabric 2
Two - 4" squares
Four - 2 5/8" squares



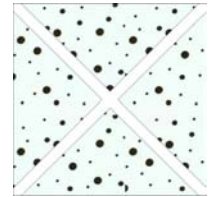
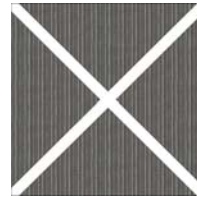
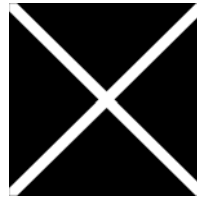
Fabric 3
Two - 4 1/4" squares



Background
Two - 4 1/4" squares
Four - 3 1/2" squares



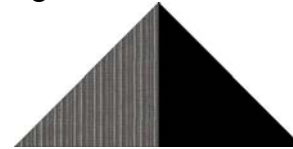
Take the 4 1/4" squares of Fabric 1, Fabric 3 and Background and cut twice on the diagonal for a total of eight triangles of each color.



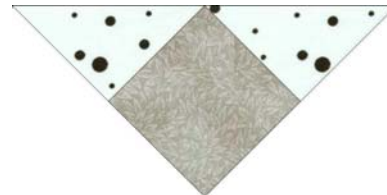
Combine the Fabric 1 and Fabric 3 triangles to make four triangle units that look like this.



Combine the Fabric 1 and Fabric 3 triangles to make four triangle units that look like this.



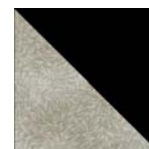
Add two Background triangles to the small Fabric 2 squares. Make four units that look like this.



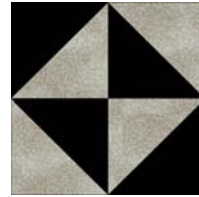
Add the small triangle units to the large triangle unit. Make four, should measure 3 1/2" x 6 1/2".



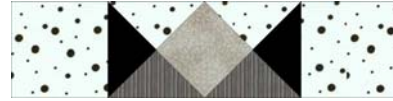
Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the large Fabric 2 squares. Place right sides together with the Fabric 1 squares, sew a scant 1/4" away from the drawn line, cut apart on the line, open and press to the darker fabric. Trim to 3 1/2".



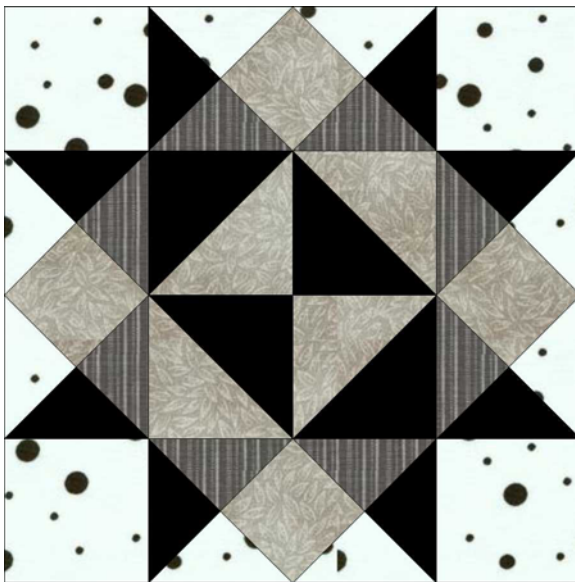
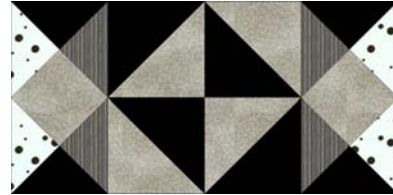
Combine half square triangles to make this block.
Block should measure 6 1/2".



Make two rows like this.



Make one row like this.



Join rows to complete block.
This is the Girls' Favorite block
and it should measure 12 1/2".
