Block of the Month - December 2009

Use a SCANT 1/4" seam allowance

Green Fabric 1
Two - 4 1/2" squares
Two - 2 1/2" squares

Gold Fabric 2
Two - 4 1/2" squares
Two - 2 1/2" squares

Red Fabric 3
Four 2 1/2" x 4 1/2"
rectangles

Background Fabric
Sixteen
2 1/2" squares

Combine 4 1/2" squares to make a 4-Patch.



Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of eight background squares. Place a square right side together with a Fabric 3 rectangle and sew on the line. Trim, open and press toward the background. Place another background square on the Fabric 3 rectangle, sew on the line. Trim, open and press toward the background. Make four flying geese.



Combine a Fabric 2 square, 2 background squares, a Fabric 1 square and a flying geese unit to make this row. Make two.



Sew a background square to each end of a flying geese unit. Make two.
Combine these units with the 4-Patch block.



Sew rows together to complete block.
Block should measure 12 1/2".
