Block of the Month - July 2009

Use a SCANT 1/4" seam allowance

Fabric 1

Four – 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles

Fabric 2

Four – 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles

Fabric 3

2 1/2" x 24" strip

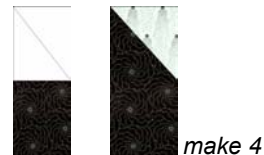
Background

One – 2 1/2" x 24" strip & Eight – 2 1/2" squares

Sew the 2 1/2" x 24" strips of Fabric 3 and background together; open and press toward Fabric 3. Cut into 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" units. Sew these units together to make four 4-Patch blocks.

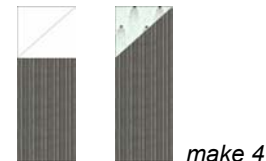


Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of four background squares. Place right sides together on a Fabric 2 rectangle, sew **ON** the line. Trim 1/4" away from the line. Should measure 2 1/2" x 4 1/2"

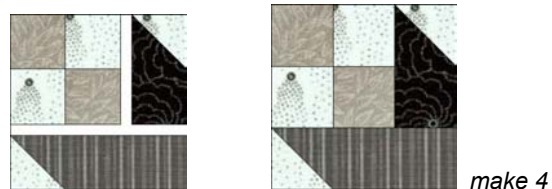


Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the remaining background squares.

Place right sides together on a Fabric 1 rectangle, sew **ON** the line. Trim 1/4" away from the line. Should measure 2 1/2" x 6 1/2"



Sew completed units into blocks.
Should measure 6 1/2".



Completed block should measure 12 1/2".
