Block of the Month - October 2009

Use a SCANT $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance

Fabric 1
Four – 4" squares

Fabric 2
Eight – 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

Background Fabric
Four – 4" squares
Four – 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the background squares. Place right sides together with the Fabric 1 squares and sew a scant $\frac{1}{2}$ " from both sides of the line. Cut apart on the drawn line, open press and trim to 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ ". Need 8.



Sew four of the half square triangles together to create a pinwheel block. Block should measure 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".



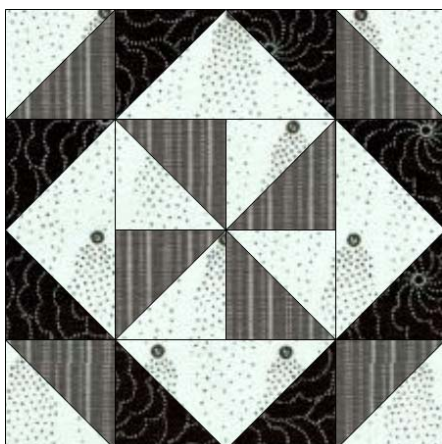
Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the eight Fabric 2 squares. Place a square right side together with a background rectangle and sew on the line. Trim, open and press away from the background. Place another Fabric 2 square on the background rectangle, sew on the line. Trim, open and press away from the background. Make four.



Combine half square triangles and a flying geese unit to make this unit. Make two



Combine the remaining flying geese and the pinwheel block.



Sew rows together to complete block.
Block should measure 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".
