Block of the Month - September 2009

Use a SCANT 1/4" seam allowance

Fabric 1
Four - 2 1/2" squares

Fabric 2
Two - 2 1/2" squares
Six - 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles

Background Fabric
Ten - 2 1/2" squares
Two - 4 1/2" squares

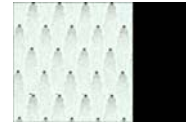
Sew together three background 2 1/2" squares, two 2 1/2" Fabric 1 squares and one 2 1/2" Fabric 2 square to make a rectangle. Make two of these.



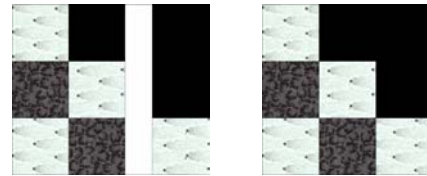
Sew a 2 1/2" background square to the end of a Fabric 2 rectangle. Make four of these.



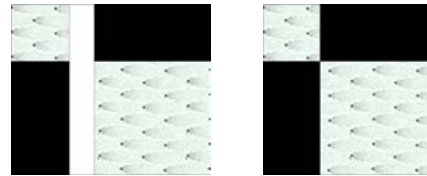
Sew a Fabric 2 rectangle to one side of a 4 1/2" background square. Make two.



Combine these units to make a 6 1/2" square. Make two.



Combine these units to make a 6 1/2" square. Make two.



Sew four 6 1/2" blocks together to complete block. Block should measure 12 1/2".
